Seniors who have not ordered a cap and gown should be prepared to pay \$45 CASH at the time of this issuance. Every effort should be made to have your gown neatly pressed before it is worn at graduation.

On May 22<sup>nd</sup>, right after picking up caps & gowns, students will pose for the senior class 10" X 30" panorama photo. The cost for the laminated print will total \$25 and needs to be paid in the exact amount at the time the photo is taken. # **Graduation Practice**

All graduating seniors are REQUIRED to attend the practice at COC on May 28<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am in the COC stadium. During this practice, each student will be given ten (10) graduation tickets for their family and friends. If your student needs more than ten, he/she must check with friends. If someone in your family needs handicapped seating, please submit a written request to Mr. Ferry in the administration office. We will allow one escort to accompany the person in the handicapped seating area. Requests are due BEFORE graduation practice. These tickets will be in place of two (2) of the regular seating tickets. Seniors who have not met their financial obligations/fines/tickets, etc. must do so before they will receive their tickets.




# **Graduation Ceremony**
